


 \mathbf{T}^{HE} unladen weight of our model R 5 is 210 lbs., and R 12 $217\frac{1}{4}$ lbs.

The late Chancellor of the Exchequer agreed to increase the maximum unladen weight limit on motor cycles to which the 30annual tax is applicable, from 200 lbs. to 224 lbs., as from the 1st of January, 1930. This would have meant that our models R 5 and R 12 would have come within this category. The present Chancellor of the Exchequer has agreed to implement this arrangement, but the necessary legislation cannot now be passed until the 1930 Budget. This means whilst buyers of the above models will have to pay the usual quarterly or annual licence at the rate of £3 per annum, it is expected, although we ourselves can give no guarantee, that the 1930 Budget will include a clause authorising the Local Taxation Authorities to repay the difference between 30/- and €3 in respect of any quarterly or annual licence which has been issued as from the 1st of January next.


